What is CRIT?

CRIT is a multidisciplinary peer group of active artists that meet on a regular basis to discuss new creative work and research in a constructive way.



What is CRIT's mission?

CRIT is a forum where artists can experiment and gain feedback on new ideas, a clearer perspective on the context of their work and motivation to explore new directions. Everyone who attends has the opportunity to learn about the work of others in an intimate way and become inspired. CRIT fosters communication, builds a support system for artists and strengthens the artistic community.

Who attends CRIT?

To get a wide variety of perspectives, we welcome participants from various fields, including but not limited to the visual arts, writing, criticism, performance, film and music. CRIT is especially geared towards advanced and professional creators who do not have regular access to critique.





What is a typical meeting like?

Usually two people volunteer to share a sampling of their work. After each presentation, attendees are invited to share their thoughts with the presenters in an open atmosphere of thoughtful and constructive criticism. During breaks we chat, snack on food, and drink wine or other refreshments.



Does work have to be finished in order to be presented?

We welcome work in various states of completion, so that the presenter can get ideas on how to move forward with the project. It is not an exhibition, and work will not be sold during CRIT.
